



# Microsoft Powerpoint 2003 Keyboard Shortcuts

<b>CTRL EQUAL SIGN</b>	Apply subscript formatting (automatic spacing) in Microsoft Powerpoint
<b>CTRL+Shift+PLUS SIGN</b>	Apply superscript formatting (automatic spacing)
<b>Run a slide show presentation</b>	
<b>N, ENTER, PAGE DOWN, RIGHT ARROW, DOWN ARROW, or the SPACEBAR (or click the mouse)</b>	Perform the next animation or advance to the next slide
<b>P, PAGE UP, LEFT ARROW, UP ARROW, or BACKSPACE</b>	Perform the previous animation or return to the previous slide in Microsoft Powerpoint
<b>number+ENTER</b>	Go to slide number
<b>B or PERIOD</b>	Display a black screen, or return to the slide show from a black screen in Microsoft Powerpoint
<b>W or COMMA</b>	Display a white screen, or return to the slide show from a white screen
<b>S or PLUS SIGN</b>	Stop or restart a Microsoft Powerpoint automatic slide show
<b>ESC, CTRL+BREAK, or HYPHEN</b>	End a slide show
<b>E</b>	Erase on-screen annotations
<b>H</b>	Go to the next hidden slide
<b>T</b>	Set new timings while rehearsing
<b>O</b>	Use original timings while rehearsing
<b>M</b>	Use mouse-click to advance while rehearsing
<b>1+ENTER (or press both mouse buttons for 2 seconds)</b>	Return to the first slide in Microsoft Powerpoint
<b>CTRL+P</b>	Redisplay hidden pointer and/or change the pointer to a pen
<b>CTRL+A</b>	Redisplay hidden pointer and/or change the pointer to an arrow
<b>CTRL+H</b>	Hide the pointer and navigation button immediately
<b>CTRL+U</b>	Hide the pointer and navigation button in 15 seconds
<b>Shift+F10 (or right-click)</b>	Display the shortcut menu (shortcut menu: A menu that shows a list of commands relevant to a particular item. To display a shortcut menu, right-click an item or press SHFT+F10.)
<b>TAB</b>	Go to the first or next hyperlink (hyperlink: Colored and underlined text or a graphic that you click to go to a file, a location in a file, a Web page on the World Wide Web, or a Web page on an intranet. Hyperlinks can also go to newsgroups and to Gopher, Telnet, and FTP sites.) on a slide
<b>Shift TAB</b>	Go to the last or previous hyperlink on a slide in Microsoft Powerpoint
<b>ENTER while a hyperlink is selected</b>	Perform the mouse click behavior of the selected hyperlink
<b>Shift+ENTER while a hyperlink is selected</b>	Perform the mouse over behavior of the selected hyperlink
<b>Browse hyperlinks in a slide show presentation</b>	
<b>TAB</b>	Go to the first or next hyperlink per slide
<b>Shift+TAB</b>	Go to the last or previous hyperlink per slide
<b>ENTER while a hyperlink is selected</b>	Perform the mouse click behavior of the selected hyperlink in Microsoft Powerpoint
<b>Shift+ENTER while a hyperlink is selected</b>	Perform the mouse over behavior of the selected hyperlink
<b>Browse Web presentations</b>	
<b>TAB</b>	Move forward through the hyperlinks in a Web presentation, the Address bar, and the Links bar
<b>Shift+TAB</b>	Move back through the hyperlinks in a Web presentation, the Address bar, and the Links bar
<b>ENTER</b>	Perform the mouse click behavior of the selected hyperlink
<b>SPACEBAR</b>	Go to the next slide in Microsoft Powerpoint
<b>BACKSPACE</b>	Go to the previous slide
<b>Send a presentation in an e-mail</b>	
<b>ALT+S</b>	Send the current presentation as an e-mail message
<b>CTRL Shift B</b>	Open the Address Book when in Microsoft Powerpoint
<b>ALT+K</b>	Check the names on the To, Cc, and Bcc lines against the Address Book
<b>TAB</b>	Select the next box in the e-mail header or the body of the message when the last box in the e-mail
